The Association of Caribbean, African and Sympathizing Students (AMECAS) is a student association affiliated to the University Paris 1- Panthéon Sorbonne. Its mission is to act as a pan-African think-tank, analyzing geopolitical, socio-cultural and economic issues in sub-Saharan Africa, North Africa and the Caribbean.

Abstract:

To showcase the work of young researchers with an interest in Africa and the Caribbean, AMECAS is organizing its first Master students' Conference on May 27.

The aim of this event is to provide a platform for students wishing to present their dissertations to a multi-disciplinary audience in a supportive environment. The idea is to bring together works that examine past and present dynamics that structure our relationship with the African continent and the Caribbean region. The event is also intended to give master's students who are considering enrolling in a PhD program the scientific communication experience they need to support their applications. Finally, it will also be an opportunity to meet and discuss with doctoral students.

Papers can be drawn from a wide range of disciplines, from political science and international relations to history, geography and sociology.

Guidelines for participation:

Participation is open to all Master's students (1st or 2nd year) currently enrolled in a higher education institution.

Proposals must be based on a research project (completed or in progress). The goal is to share hypotheses and results by preparing a 15-20 minute presentation, which will then be commented on by a discussant.

The paper should be between 500 and 1000 words long, and can be written in either French or English. It should be sent in PDF format to the following address: <u>amecas.journeemasters@gmail.com</u> no later than April 27, 2025.
